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
**FLORIDA AUDUBON SOCIETY, INC.'S  
NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE AMICUS CURIAE BRIEF**

FLORIDA AUDUBON SOCIETY, INC. (“Florida Audubon”), pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.370(d), hereby gives notice of its intent to seek leave of Court to file an amicus curiae brief on the merits in support of the Petitioners should the Court accept jurisdiction in this matter.

Florida Audubon is a state-wide, not-for-profit public interest organization founded in 1900. Florida Audubon has thousands of members and various chapters throughout Florida, and frequently appears at local quasi-judicial land use hearings on behalf of its members whose interests will be directly and adversely affected by proposed land use actions. In the decision below, the Fifth District

Court of Appeal held that only developers and local governments have a due process right to cross-examine witnesses during a quasi-judicial hearing, and that affected parties have no similar right. Florida Audubon has an interest in this matter because of the substantial adverse impact the Fifth District's decision has on the due process rights of affected parties, including their right to create a fair and complete record during a quasi-judicial hearing and to rely upon such record in seeking meaningful judicial review of the quasi-judicial decision.

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
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
