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**PUTNAM CITIZENS ALLIANCE, INC.'S  
NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE AMICUS CURIAE BRIEF**

PUTNAM CITIZENS ALLIANCE, INC. ("PCA"), pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.370(d), hereby gives notice of its intent to seek leave of Court to file an amicus curiae brief on the merits in support of the Petitioners should the Court accept jurisdiction in this matter.

PCA is a not-for-profit citizen organization formed in 2006 and located in Putnam County, Florida. One of PCA's main purposes is to help protect Putnam County's existing agricultural areas and residential neighborhoods from incompatible land development. PCA members who stood to be adversely affected by proposed zoning actions have appeared in the past, and will likely continue to

appear, at quasi-judicial hearings held by governmental bodies in Putnam County. PCA and its members have a special interest in this matter because of the substantial adverse impact the Fifth District's decision will have on the ability of "affected parties," as defined in *Renard v. Dade County*, 261 So. 2d 832 (Fla. 1972), to create a complete record, via cross-examination of adverse witnesses as well as by the presentation of direct testimony, during quasi-judicial land use hearings and to rely on such record in seeking meaningful judicial review of quasi-judicial land use decisions.
