NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE AMICUS CURIAE BRIEF**

SCENIC AMERICA-FLORIDA CHAPTER, INC., a/k/a Citizens for a Scenic Florida, Inc. ("Scenic Florida"), pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.370(d), hereby gives notice of its intent to seek leave of Court to file an amicus curiae brief on the merits in support of the Petitioners should the Court accept jurisdiction in this matter.

STATEMENT OF INTEREST TO AMICUS CURIAE

Scenic Florida is a Florida non-profit corporation which promotes programs that preserve and enhance landscapes, that enhance scenic approaches and improve community appearance, and that foster the establishment and preservation of

scenic road systems. To that end, Scenic Florida and its members appear at local and state hearings to protect their interests which could be directly and adversely affected by proposed land use actions. Scenic Florida has a special interest in this matter because the Fifth District's decision restricts the standing of neighboring property owners in local quasi-judicial hearings by denying them the right of cross-examination, and, thus, substantially and adversely affects the due process rights of affected parties, such as Scenic Florida and its members, to fully and meaningfully participate in quasi-judicial land use proceedings.
